On behalf of Hillross, I congratulate Mark Heanly for his outstanding achievement in winning the **2014 Hillross Service to the Community Award**.

This prestigious award was open to all Hillross advisers across Australia. The winner was carefully selected by a panel of judges from the Hillross Leadership Team.

Mark has been Chairman of the Scone Grammar School for 10 years. During that time student numbers have increased from 315 to 600 and the school spent nearly \$3m on infrastructure.

Mark has spent the past 18 months putting together a fund raising epic adventure called Cooktown to Kokoda, where he and his team set out to ride mountain bikes from Cooktown to Cape York, some 900 kilometres, then sea kayak across the Torres Strait for 200 kilometres and then walk the 96 gruelling kilometres of the Kokoda track. The purpose of this adventure was :

1. To raise awareness of breast cancer in the communities of Cape York and the Torres Strait; and
2. To raise much needed funds for the McGrath Foundation.

Mark has raised \$65,000 and with a few more events to be held, this amount will be \$70,000.

This award recognises the value he provides to his community and clients.

I thank Mark Heanly for his commitment and support, which has contributed to the overall success of Hillross.
